Course Description:

This nine-week course is designed to equip participants with the essential principles for living a steadfast Christian life while eagerly awaiting the return of Christ. The curriculum will guide participants through key themes in the Old Testament and other biblical passages. We will study the lives of specific people so that we can have a practical and joyful understanding of what it means to be a faithful follower of Christ preparing for His return.

Patterns for us in the Old Testament:

- 1. Noah: Steadfast in preparation against worldly compromise (Gen. 6 and Hebrew 11:7)
- 2. Abraham: Steadfast in Journeying, Seeking the city (Hebrew 11:9-10)
- 3. Joseph: Steadfast in Suffering, Waiting for Exaltation (Psalm 105:19)
- 4. Moses: Steadfast in Choice, Seeing the Invisible Reward (Hebrew 11:27)
- 5. Caleb: Steadfast in Following Fully, Claiming the Inheritance (Numbers 14.24)
- 6. Elijah: Steadfast in Zeal, Taken by Translation (2 Kings 2:11)
- 7. Daniel: Steadfast in Purity, Waiting for the End (Daniel 12:13)
- 8. The Faithful Remnant: Steadfast in Expectation (Malachi 3:16)
- 9. The Priests and Levites: Steadfast in Service and Intercession (Psalm 122:1)
- 10. Isaiah's prophecy: Steadfast in hope of the final consummation (Isaiah 53:11)

Course structure: Each week:

- 1. There will be sections from the Bible to read before the class
- 2. During the class the teachers will both share from these verses and lead a discussion on how to apply them to our lives so we all can be faithful followers of Christ preparing for His return
